



THE BIBLE AND THE SACRAMENTS - A 6-SESSION BIBLE STUDY

"The Bible and the Sacraments" is an exciting new parish Bible study produced by the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology in Steubenville, Ohio. This study runs for only 6 sessions... a length that is easily manageable for the average parishioner.

This study examines basic teaching of the Church as to the meaning and origin of the Sacraments and investigates the deeper mysteries they contain as illuminated by Scripture. The student will learn where they come from, what they mean, and why they are so important and foundational to our faith. This 6-session study explores the 7 Sacraments from a Biblical point-of-view, bringing the participant to a greater appreciation of Sacred Scripture and the sacramental life of the Church. True to Catholic tradition, "The Bible and the Sacraments" trains its sights on Scripture's literal-historical and spiritual senses; yet it never reduces the study of Scripture to mere apologetics or proof-texting. It incorporates live presentation, multimedia, small group discussion and some outside reading.

How does it work?

"The Bible and the Sacraments" is presented by anyone who wishes to bring this study to their parish or particular group. Presenters need not have a degree in Theology or an advanced level of academic expertise. The training is suited to faithful Catholics living an active sacramental life who want to grow in their knowledge of the Bible and are willing to make an effort to study, read, and pray; to enter into the Word of God and share it with their fellow Catholics. All you need is to be trained, and we will provide that training on **Saturday, August 21, 2010**. We are flying in two highly-qualified trainers from the St. Paul Center to lead us in this training.

Presenter Notes

We know that the task of putting on a parish Bible study may seem daunting. For this reason, we want to take as much of the burden off of the presenters as possible. At the training, you will receive Presenter Notes for each of the six sessions. This is not a mere outline. It is the actual Bible study presentation, word-for-word.

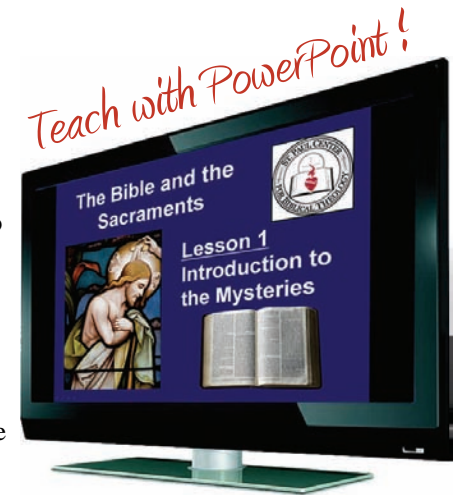
PowerPoint Slides

In addition, presenters receive a PowerPoint Presentation of the study. The PowerPoint is displayed at the same time the presenter is speaking when the study is administered in a parish setting. This means students receive instruction that is both oral and visually dynamic.

Student Workbook

We also provide the student workbook which follow the Presenter Notes. The outlines follow the PowerPoint presentation and the notes are detailed summaries of each session for review.
