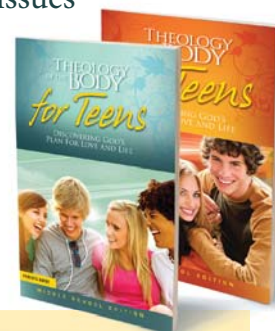


Love and Relationships: Talking to Your Teens About Chastity
