Dr. Steve Colecchi, the U.S. Catholic Bishops Director of the Office of International Peace and Justice will spend the day with the Sacramento Deacon Community exploring the importance of peace building as integral to living out the call of the Gospel. He will review the Bishop's Campaign for Peace in the Holy Land, describe the situation there, explain new possibilities and suggest how deacons can assist in responding to the Bishops' plea.



He has traveled extensively in the Holy Land with various U.S. Bishops visiting not just the holy sites made of stone, but also the living stones – the marginalized and suffering people in the Occupied Territories of Palestine. He is the Bishops' main point person on Middle East Policy and Peace and represents them before the United States Executive and Legislative Branches.
